
This year, we mark the 200<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the War of 1812. The grounds upon which the Warriors' Day Parade has marched for the last 91 years holds great significance for the War of 1812, especially in 1813 when the Battle of York took place on the northern shores of Lake Ontario.

The Saluting Dais will be located on the north side of Princes' Boulevard, west of the Princes' Gates. The Parade will continue along Princes' Boulevard and turn left into the area surrounding historic Stanley Barracks.

Spectators may view the parade from along its route through the CNE grounds. The area just west of the Princes' Gates will offer a spectacular experience. Like last year, this area promises to be crowded, so we encourage spectators to arrive early in order to gain a premium spot. The CNE will again be erecting a number of grandstand-style bleacher seats on the south side of Princes' Boulevard, available for spectators on a first come basis.

Many contingents have already registered for participation in the Parade and we anticipate a significant turn out of participants and spectators for our 91st parade!



We hope you will join us again this year for what promises to be a tremendous celebration of Canada's incredible military heritage. Together we will collectively pay tribute to our Veterans and our Military,

those who will be with us that day, and the many who are in our hearts and memories.
