What: The 103rd Anniversary Annual Warriors' Day Parade

When: Saturday, August 17, 2024

9:00 – 10:15 AM – Gore Park. Parade begins to form up. Photo and interview opportunities with Veterans.

9:50 – 10:20 AM – Area around Saluting Dais – (Saluting Dais located on the north side of Princes' Boulevard in front of the Enercare Centre, Hall "D" Entrance). VIPs meet with Veterans from Sunnybrook War Veteran's Hospital. Photo opportunities.

10:00 – 10:20 AM The Band of The Royal Regiment of Canada will play in front of the Saluting Dais.

10:05 AM VIP's take their places in the Saluting Dais area. Major-General David Fraser, CMM, MSC, MSM, CD (Ret'd) Honorary Colonel of The Queen's Own Rifles of Canada on the Saluting Dais.

10:10 AM The Band of The Royal Regiment of Canada play the National Anthem followed by the Royal Anthem.

10:15 AM Two minutes of silence in tribute to all those who gave their lives in defense of Canada and its allies.

Last Post and Reveille will be played, including the Piper's Lament

Band marches back to Enercare Centre Parking Area.

10:30 AM Parade begins with the entrance of the Toronto Police Service Mounted Unit and the Honour Section.

10:35 AM Parade stops in front of the Saluting Dais. Honourary Parade Marshals dismount and move to the Saluting Dais. Parade resumes.

Where: The Canadian National Exhibition / Princes' Gates - Parade will march

through the historic Princes' Gates and along Princes' Boulevard and make its way through the CNE grounds. The Saluting Dais will be located on the north side of Princes Blvd., just west of the Princes'

Gates.

Who: More than 1,500 Veterans and currently serving members of the

Canadian Armed Forces, including Canadian veterans from World War

II, the Korean War, Afghanistan, other recent conflicts and

peacekeeping missions. As well, police, fire, and paramedic services

will march in the parade.
